The junior species that count for the tournament are: Sunfish, Yellow Perch, White Perch, Crappie, Pickerel, Striped Bass, Bluefish, Scup and Bonito. Each category has a year end pay out of a \$200.00 certificate For the angler with the highest point total. All juniors are welcome to weigh in fish at the Club and participate – membership not necessary. The Adult categories compete for annual trophy and bragging rites for the year. One member is crowned "Angler of the Year", which the prize is to have their dues paid for the year. Just think – it could be you! We also have a ton of tournaments for all to get involved.
