Monthly Certificates are given to the Angler with the largest of each specie acknowledged on the Club's Tally Board. There are 3 categories – Male, Female and Junior. Both traditional and Fly Rod count. Each specie (per category) is given a \$10.00 certificate per month if someone has weighed one in. Why not see your name on the board! The year long tournament is open to all members; free of charge. That is divided into Male, Female and 3 age groups of Juniors being 0-6, 7-11, 12-15. Any child over 15 must compete as an adult. The junior species that count for the tournament are: Sunfish, Yellow Perch, White Perch, Crappie, Pickerel, Striped Bass, Bluefish, Scup and Bonito. Each category has a year end pay out of a \$200.00 certificate For the angler with the highest point total. All juniors are welcome to weigh in fish at the Club and participate – membership not necessary. The Adult categories compete for annual trophy and bragging rites for the year. One member is crowned "Angler of the Year", which the prize is to have their dues paid for the year. Just think – it could be you! We also have a ton of tournaments for all to get involved.
