*** Just a few refresher reminders regarding the minimum sizes for fish to be weighed at the Club or roving scales. Pickerel – 15", White Perch and Crappie – 8", Yellow Perch – 7", Sunfish – 4", Bluefish – 12", Striped Bass – 28" – less than 31", Scup – beach – 9.5" – boat -10.5", Black Sea Bass – 16.5", and Fluke – 16.5". Please try to conserve fish and only weigh in the two largest or may bump prior caught fish.

***Please give name and member number to servers at club as many members seem to have forgotten their correct number and others are getting their credits. Ask your server for your number – a lot of people store it in their phones for remembering.

The Club is open 7 days a week, as we are in our summer season.
